Retention Requirements

- You must earn a **MINIMUM 3.00 SEMESTER & CUMULATIVE GPA**
- You must be continuously enrolled full-time each semester (minimum 12 hours).
- You must attempt and pass no less than 24 hours per academic year. The academic year is defined as the combination of the Fall and Spring semester.
