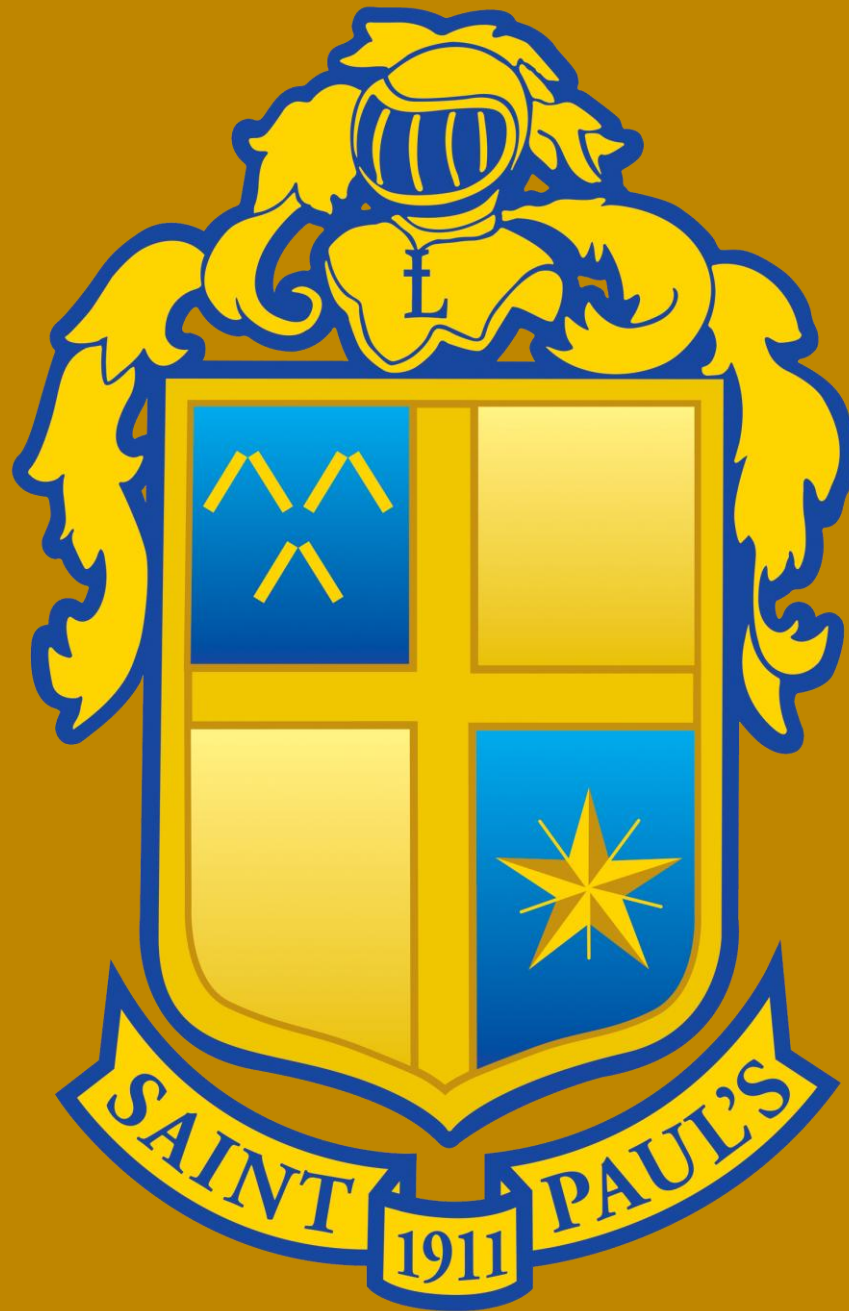

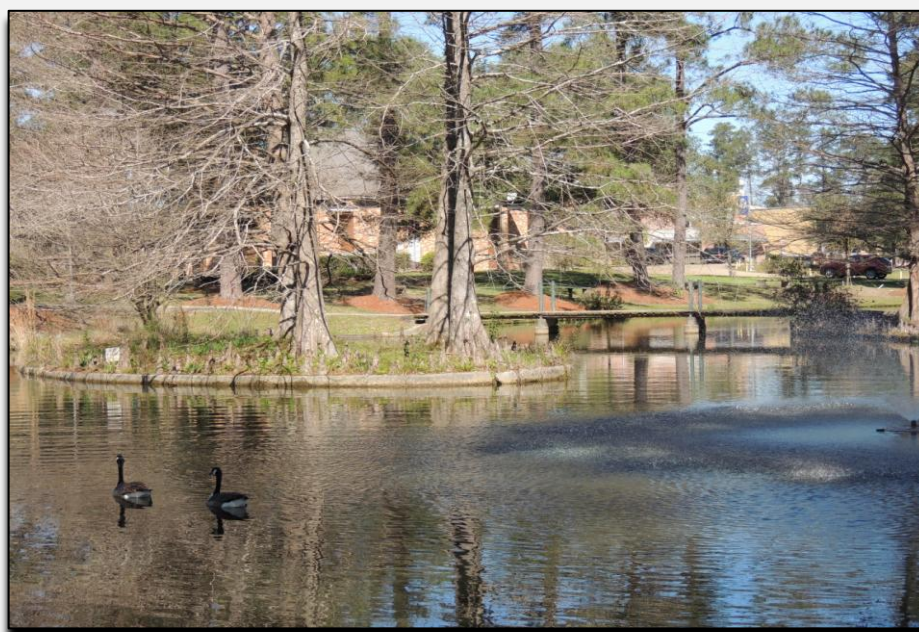
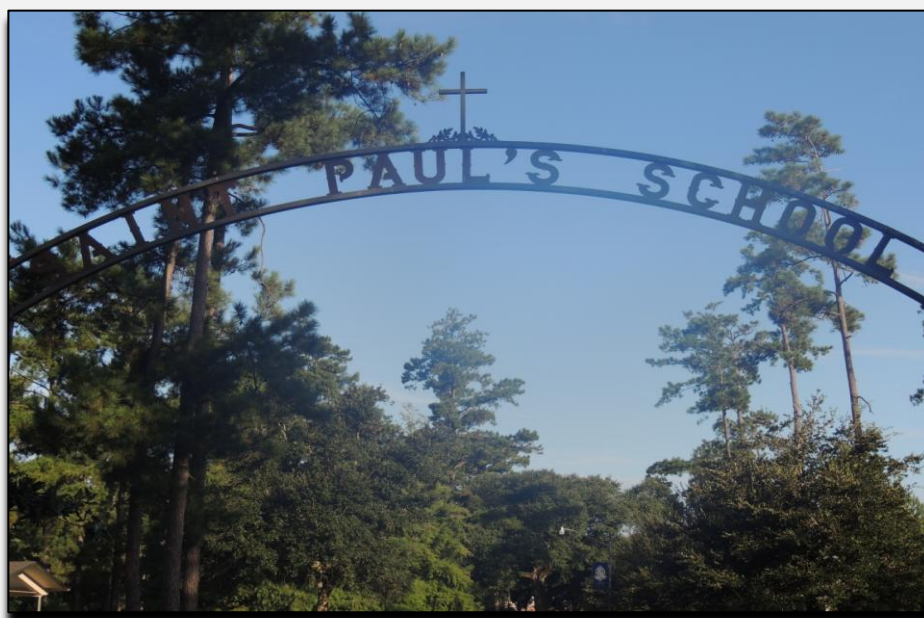

The rich tradition of Lasallian education dates back to 1680 when St. John Baptist de La Salle, a prominent French priest, founded the Brothers of the Christian Schools “to give a human and Christian education to the young, especially the poor and working class.” De La Salle transformed education by forming a community of educators with whom he developed a spirituality of teaching and learning. In 1918, seven years after the Benedictines of Saint Joseph Abbey founded Saint Paul’s School, the De La Salle Christian Brothers brought that legacy to Covington, Louisiana – and it has flourished here ever since.

Lasallian Education centers on Catholic values and personal relationships, emphasizing our five core principles:

- Quality education
- Inclusive community
- Respect for all
- Concern for the poor and social justice, especially through service

## From the Alumni Director



As I noted at the onset of this year's Annual Fund appeal to the alumni in December, the past numbers in regard to alumni support have been rather dismal. While we are by no means on par with our alumni support as we are with other comparative indicators in association with our history, growth, tradition and success, there is certainly good reason to celebrate our progress.

The number of contributors for 2014 has increased by 251% to 179. On behalf of my department, our administration, the faculty, students and contributing alumni, I wish to express a most sincere and heartfelt THANK YOU.

The largest catalyst to this year's success was simply awareness. Most of our alumni were unaware of the Fund and of how few of our "Brothers" were supporting it.

Local expert Frank Donaldson calls the Annual Fund "the single most important Development Process that a Catholic Institution could ever do." There is still a great deal of work ahead which will be highlighted with the start of this year's 2015 appeal. However, I sincerely hope that we all enjoy the short term success, that you continue to help spread awareness, and that you assist me in furthering the cause into 2015.

The proceeds from your efforts for the 2014 appeal will be used as follows:

Restricted Gifts - \$10,000,  
Classroom Improvements \$15,000  
Biomedical Sciences and Engineering \$50,000  
Faculty Professional Development/Education/ Compensation \$55,000  
Technology (Campus Wi Fi, computers etc.) \$50,000  
Architectural Renderings & Engineering Tests for New Gym \$160,000  
Postage & Printing: \$3,000

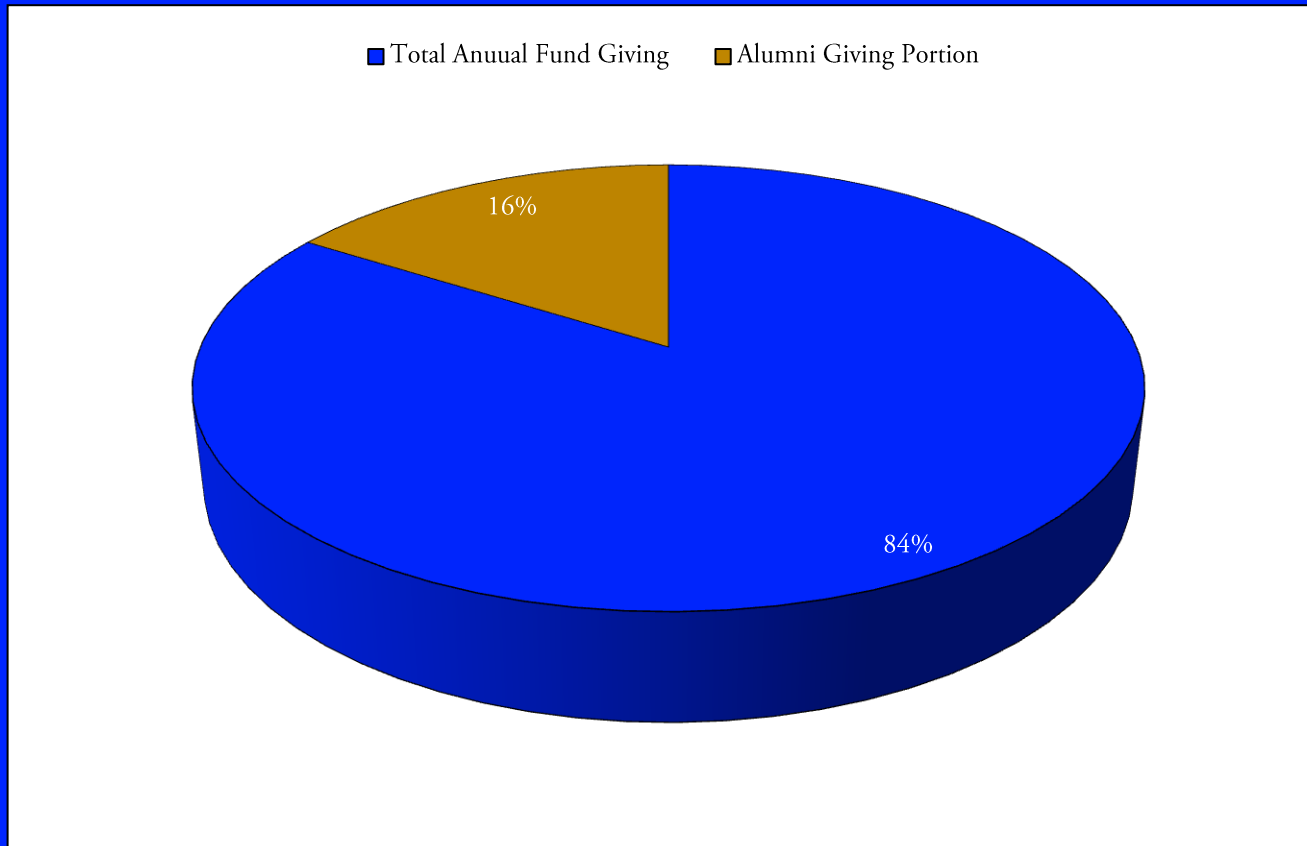
Please note that the Annual Fund runs for a fiscal year. This 2014 report will reflect only the donations received from our alumni to the Annual Fund between August 1, 2013 and July 31, 2014. In light of the moderate recent influx of donors, the 2014 Alumni Gifting Societies included in the report represent the amount pledged on an annual basis independent of when the pledge was made during the fiscal year. For example, a \$10 a month pledge made in July of 2014 for a duration of one year would otherwise only register as \$10 received and would not place the donor in a society at all. This report reflects the total value of the \$120 amount pledged and will place the donor in the "Strength of the Pack" society.

# Contribution Summary



## Saint Paul's School Crest



The Saint' Paul's School Crest originally surfaced in 1962 in response to the transition from Saint Paul's College to Saint Paul's School. Traditional in symbolism and appearance, the coat of arms depicts a face shield for protection in battle as well as mantling which was used to guard against the elements. The cross within the center of the shield symbolizes Christian Faith and also serves as a means of aesthetic balance. The Chevrons in the upper right quadrant of the cross were believed to be from a La Salle family crest. The star located in the bottom right of the shield has become an iconic image in Lasallian Heritage and is looked upon by Lasallians as a Sign of

Sign of Faith," Signum Fidei," as the Star of Bethlehem led the Wise Men of the East to Jesus despite the threats from Herod. It was this "holy audacity" and courageous act to follow the star that embodies what Lasallians represent. Accordingly, the star now symbolizes a beacon to follow one's calling to develop his or her talents and to use those gifts to better the world around them.

Over the last 50 years, St. Paul's has seen many subtle variations of the crest through graphic design and printer changes which many did not even realize. In May of 2013, Brother Raymond Bulliard generated the latest version. This new look included cleverly editing the pectoral line located in the breastplate to incorporate the recently branded Lasallian "L." Today, the crest ,our academic icon ,is worn on the uniform shirt of every student and can subsequently be seen all over campus and at times throughout the local community.

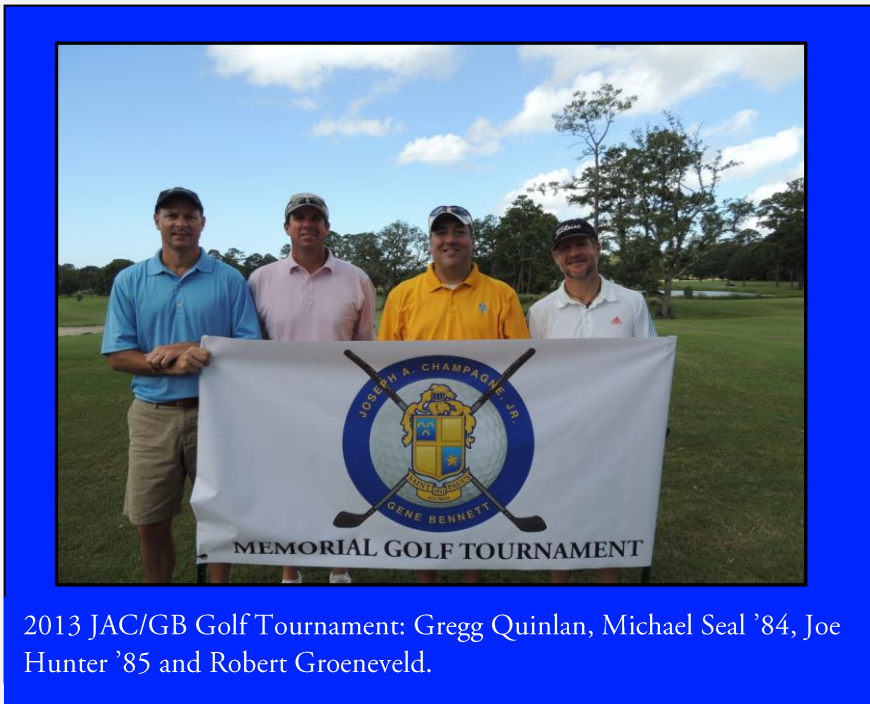


