The **Signum Fidei** (the Sign of Faith) is part of the official seal of the Brothers of the Christian Schools. It symbolically represents the integration of the five Core Lasallian Principles:

Quality Education

Respect for All Persons

Inclusive Community

Concern for the Poor and Social Justice

Faith in the Presence of God

Each of these principles is significant, but it is only in their union that the Lasallian Mission is fully realized.
