As brothers of the Son of Man, rise up, O men of God!

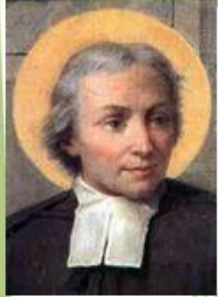

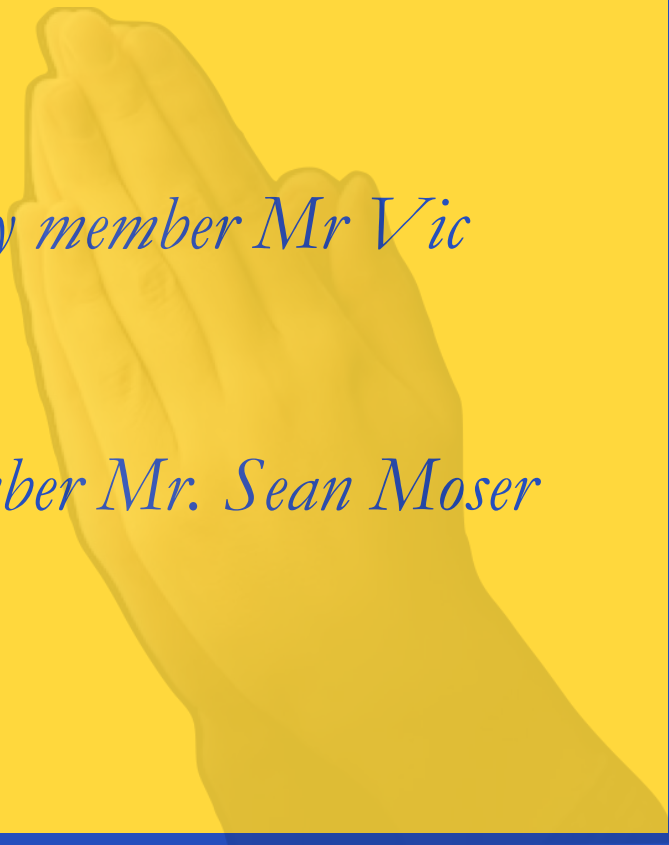

(Thuret, south-central France)

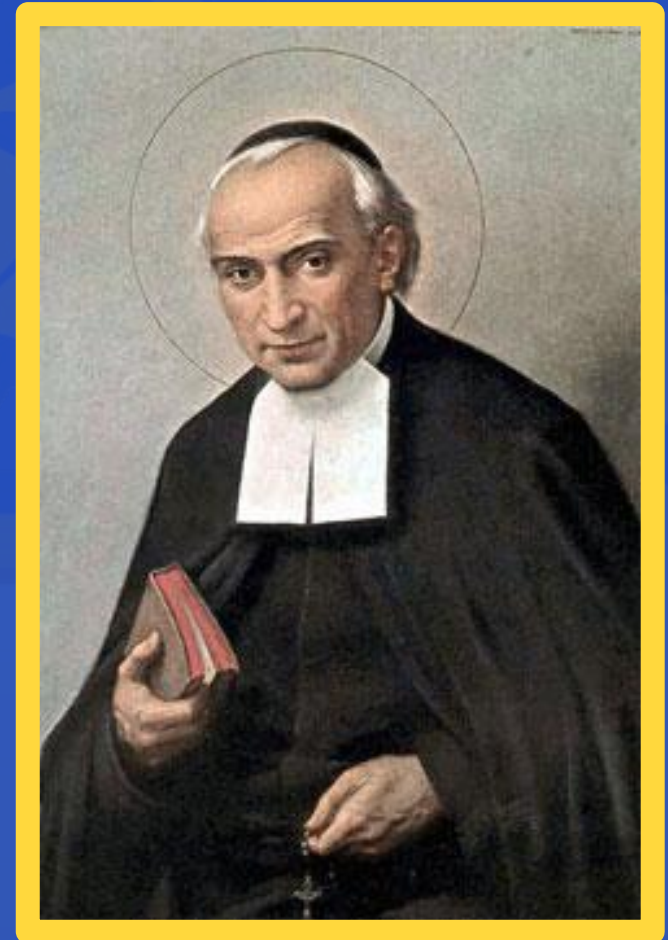
Died: August 13, 1862

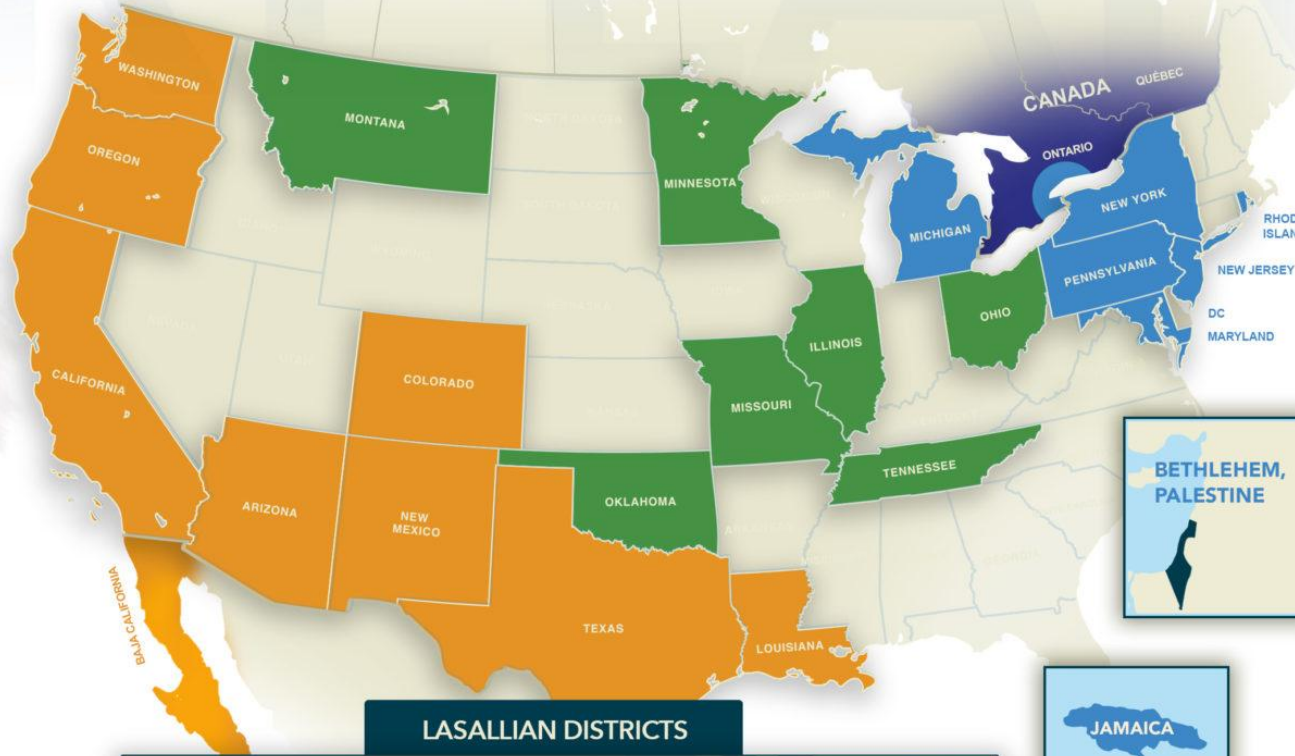

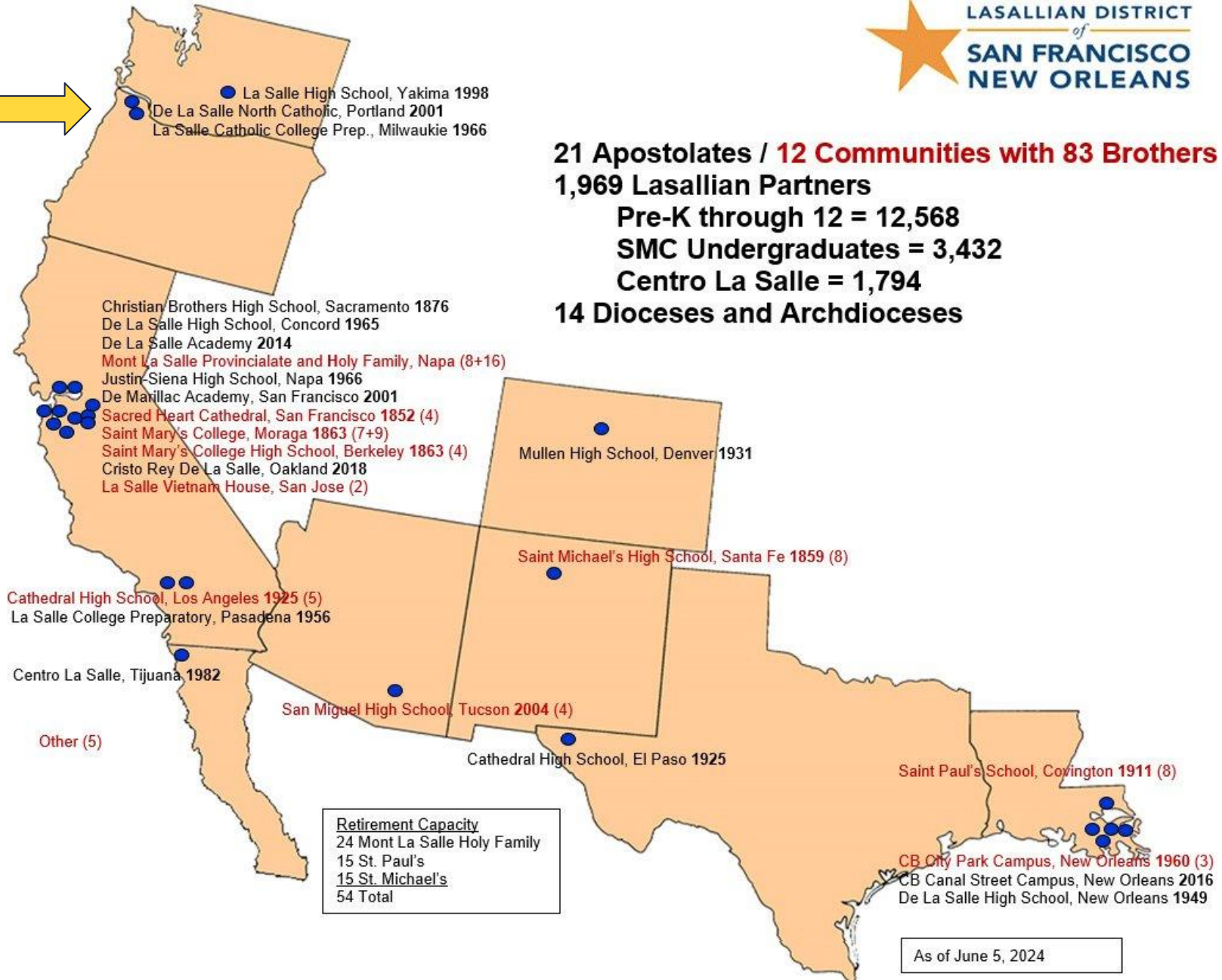

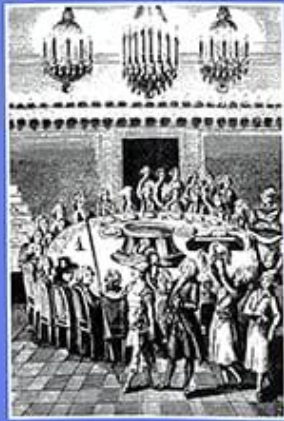
